This yearly, week-long event provides a traditional lifetime camping experience for these special children and is handicap accessible. Activities include swimming, arts and crafts, sports, fishing, talent show, special events and much more. Facilities include air-conditioned dormitories, indoor restrooms and showers, three nutritious meals daily, and a nurse on duty for the duration of camp. The STD Specialty Clinic provides confidential or anonymous HIV testing, as well as Syphilis, Gonorrhea and Chlamydia testing and treatment. Other STD services are available, some of which may require an additional fee. The usual STD fee is \$20.00. Walk-ins are welcome but patients are seen on a first come, first serve basis. Please arrive early to be sure that you will be seen and call the clinic or visit the website for complete hours.
